Module Description

[MOD3102] Basic English for Academic Communication

This module aims to develop the basic language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. By the module's end, learners should be able to understand simple, clear, and slow speech on everyday topics, identifying familiar names and phrases. They should interact using repetition and rephrasing, ask and answer basic questions, and manage simple exchanges. They should also understand short, simple texts, picking up basic information and writing isolated phrases with simple connectors.

[MOD3103] Enhancing English Skills for Academic setting.

This module aims to develop intermediate language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. By the module's end, learners should comprehend standard speech encountered in personal, social, academic, or vocational life, though they may struggle with idiomatic usage. They should speak fluently, accurately, and effectively on a wide range of topics, communicating spontaneously and fluently. They should read and understand most texts, adapting their style and speed of reading as needed. In writing, they should express opinions effectively and convey information on abstract and concrete topics.

[MOD3104] Advanced English for Academics Learning

This module aims to develop the advanced language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. By the end of the module, learners should understand extended speech on abstract and complex topics, recognize idiomatic expressions, and follow unstructured speech. They should comprehend demanding texts and infer implicit meanings. In speaking, they should skilfully contribute to discussions. In writing, they should produce clear, well-structured texts on complex subjects.
